	\rightarrow SFC gave an u-date on the 3 injured Rhinos players from Monday night 's match	
	 Donnell Wallam had broken her arm. The recovery time was not know at this stage but she is expected to be back before the end of the season 	
	 Twaine Keenan and Fi Toner had their scans and an up-date was imminent 	
	\rightarrow There had only been 2 cases of Covid within the squad and they were university based.	
	Testing was thorough and regular for the players and staff	
	\rightarrow It was financially tough for all the franchises including Rhinos as they had no income
