 - MP to attend a national meeting with Imo Greatbach (EN Head of Volunteering) who is looking at developing a toolkit for Counties, Regions, Clubs to help them with recruitment

8. EN Competition Review: Rachael Radford

- → Rachael Joined the meeting at 18:50 hours
- → A competition review presentation was sent out to the RMB prior to the meeting and Rachael gave a brief overview of where we are now and what the proposed changes would be. The main points were:
 - The Region are seeking to increase the number of clubs playing in the EN premier league as at present the Region have only one. The proposed target would be to get one new team within 2 years and 2 new teams within 5 years, which would increase the amount of Yorkshire teams in the premier league to 4 in total. To support this aim, Regional competition would need to become stronger by:

Ensuring more regular regional competition Working with clubs to ensure those who want to progress and access EN competition are able to do so Use the regional league as a route to the Premier league instead of the Northern league, which is the present route which would bring Yorkshire in line with most other Regions. This would be done by: Creating 2 divisions of 8 The present Yorkshire clubs playing in Northern League would move to Yorkshire league division one The present Yorkshire league teams move to division two If the structure doesn't work after year one, review the structure Next steps September 2021 – look at the development structure for junior Evolve senior competition – review whether the 2 divisions of 8 works Educate clubs on the regional competition and how it fits into the EN competition pathway Proactively engage in communication with the Leeds Rhinos franchise regarding competition and performance clubs/competition to support the development of Yorkshire's competition strategy The Board agreed with the proposals that Rachael put forward 9 Website (Current & Future): (MP) → The new ENgage website will be launched imminently even though the competition element isn't fully functioning at present. To get this function up and running EN have asked Regions to contribute £5k Action Point: Look into buying yorkshirenetball.net & Yorkshire netball.org at a cost of around £50 MP each for two years - Completed DC Action Point: Once the URLs have been purchased, contact the current website provider to give notice of his services -Notice given to Paul Stretton and the old website has now been taken down - completed MP Action Point: Look into the cost of buying emails for individual RMB members eq
