

Competitions & Officiating Group Member Yorkshire Netball



Introduction

Yorkshire Regional Netball Association is one of nine member organisations of England Netball and is managed by a management board of volunteers. We represent England Netball members in Yorkshire and work closely with England Netball staff to deliver and develop netball in Yorkshire.

The Yorkshire Board works closely with our four County Netball Associations: Humberside Netball, North Yorkshire Netball, South Yorkshire Netball and West Yorkshire Netball. We also work closely with Leeds Rhinos Netball, our member leagues, clubs, education institutions and other key stakeholders who share our commitment to delivering great netball experiences in Yorkshire.

Competition & Officiating Working Group

The working group is a subgroup of the Regional Management Board. The group are responsible for:

General

- Provision of support, guidance, and advice to County Competition Working Group Leads
- Supporting the development of updates and reports for key meetings such as Regional Management Meetings and the AGM
- Adhering to the Regional Management Board Code of Behavior

• Attend meeting that's support the work undertaken by the group, these may involve County, Region, England Netball

Competition

- Support with the planning and delivery of regional competitions (Leagues and Tournaments)
- Proactively disseminate information to county / clubs regarding Regional Competition Opportunities
- Support with the identification and organising of training and education opportunities for Competition volunteers.
- Competition administration support for one of the organised Regional League Competitions
- Support at specified Regional Led Tournaments

Officiating

- Keeping England Netball's Learning and Development Team up to date on the need and appetite in Yorkshire for officiating courses
- Disseminate information to county / clubs regarding Competition Opportunities
- Support the administration of B Umpire Award Assessments, collating information and liaising with identified assessors.
- Support member counties in fostering and raising the standards of umpires.
- Support with the identification and organising of training and education opportunities for officiating volunteers.
- Support with the appointment of umpires at identified Regional Competition (e.g. regional round of National Schools)

Time Commitment

The role will require volunteering approximately 4 hours per month on average, with some months of the year in which competitions are held being busier, others quieter.

Meetings are a mix of in person where possible, hybrid, and more typically online via Zoom, you will need access to email, WhatsApp, phone and Zoom

- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Good IT skills (Including Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint & Publisher)
- Ability to be flexible and work with volunteers from diverse backgrounds to build and maintain effective networks.
- Take an interest in and respect the viewpoints of others.
- Access to email, WhatsApp and telephone
