


Regional Tournament Results Bench

Introduction

Yorkshire Regional Netball Association runs and supports several regional netball tournament events throughout the year. These events are a great way to volunteer in netball if you don't have the time to make a regular commitment to a club or organisation.

Key responsibilities

- 1. Ensure that the tournament schedule runs to time
- 2. Check and collate tournament match results, inputting into the tournament results table (Computer and paper) for teams and spectators to keep upto date with results

- 3. Raise any queries regarding timing schedule, results with the Tournament Referees, who will be responsible for taking appropriate action
- 4. Support the Tournament Referee's with the registration of all clubs/teams at the start of the competition ensuring that all entry conditions have been adhered to in accordance with the Competition Regulations

- Good communicator
- Good attention to detail
- A team player who can also work on own initiative.
- Able to be flexible and adaptable in a dynamic environment.
- Working knowledge of Computers (specifically use of Microsoft Excel)

The applicant must be a minimum of 18 years of age (at the point of application)
